Look around to be sure there isn't any debris or shrink wrap loose and blowing around. This can get into the beam path and cause the alarm to be set off.

If you plug into the electric be sure to unplug before you leave. This is a safety rule which we strictly adhere to.

Soon we'll be getting our boats ready for launching. Remember to secure your ladder when working on your boat and work safely. Also, you are responsible for disposing of your shrink wrap. Do not put it in the Club dumpsters, take it home.

New York State Boating Law will change for 2014 Season

New York State has passed a new law requiring all persons under 18 years of age to complete a boating safety course to operate a boat with a motor as of May 1, 2014. This law does not apply to sail or paddle powered boats.

Many States, including New Jersey and Connecticut have had similar laws on the books for several years, and now require a boating safety course for people of all ages. All three states require a certificate/license for operating Personal Watercraft (Jet Skis) at any age. If you have a certificate from another state that is NASBLA (National Association of State Boating Law Administrators) approved, it will be accepted by NY State. Your New York State certificate will be accepted in any other state, and courses given by the USCG Auxiliary and the US Power Squadron are approved. If you have not taken one of these courses, you might strongly consider doing so, even if you are over 18. They emphasize the basics of boating safety and seamanship, as well as reviewing the local laws and regulations. Even if you are an experienced boater, it is always good to review. You never know, there may be something that is new, different, or that you simply forgot.

Motorboats

All individuals born on or after 5/1/96 are now required to successfully complete an approved course in boater education in order to operate a motorboat. Approved courses include those offered by NYS Parks, the US Coast Guard Auxiliary or the US Power Squadron. Individuals less than 10 years of age *may not* take this course of instruction.

Personal Watercraft

Operators may not operate a Personal Watercraft (JetSki, SeaDoo, etc.) unless they are at least 14 years of age and hold a boater safety certificate issued by State Parks, the USCG Auxiliary or the US Power Squadron for having completed a an 8-hour classroom based course of instruction.

A person without a safety certificate may operate a PWC when accompanied by someone over 18 years of age who is the holder of a boater safety certificate. For the purposes of this section, "accompanied" shall mean upon the same PWC.
