From Cruising Fleet Chairman Jeff Burtch

Summer Cruise up the Hudson Week of August 11–18, 2013

We plan to spend the middle of the week, Tuesday–Thursday (8/13 through 8/15) at **Donovan's Shady Harbor Marina** in New Baltimore. The marina has a pool, picnic canopy and tables, a restaurant on site, and a ship's store with some gourmet items, beverages and essentials. The location is in New Baltimore (about 20 miles south of Albany) opposite Houghtailing Island and Schodack Island State Park which is a great place to explore by kayak or dinghy. There is no "downtown," but there are some lovely streets up the hill for a pleasant walk.

Shady Harbor Marina (518-756-8001) will hold a block of 10 slips for us until the **July 13 deadline**. If you plan to join us, now is the time to make your reservation. Please call for your own reservation and say you are with Minisceongo Cruising Fleet, and you will be included in the group. *We will get one (1) day as a reciprocal (free) the other two (2) days will be \$2/ft. and \$8/day for electricity.*

We plan to leave Sunday morning (8/11), and head to Kingston for one or two nights, then on to Shady Harbor. We plan to have dinner together at the restaurant on Wednesday night and BBQ potluck supper the other nights. Some boats may plan to continue north to the canals and or Lake Champlain. On Friday we plan to stop in Catskill and somewhere south of Kingston on Saturday. (See list below). Some boats might wish to stop for the Kingston Antique Boat show on August 17–18.

There is a Holiday Inn Express nearby in West Coxsackie for those interested in a land cruise.

There are many other places to visit, and a few anchorages along the way. It is hard to find a wake-free spot to drop the hook, but things quiet down in the evening.

Alternative stops (marinas) along the Hudson River from south to north:

- ☞ **West Shore Marine** in Marlboro 845-236-4486. Funky old docks and nice people. A good hike up the hill to the Raccoon Saloon. It is just south of the Marlboro Yacht Club.
- ☞ **Marlboro Yacht Club** 845-236-3932 very nice facilities. Both are a bit north of Chelsea on the west shore.
- ☞ **Shadows Marina** in Poughkeepsie 845-486-9500 (Dockmaster: 845-518-4459) New facility near the bridge – east shore.
- ☞ **Poughkeepsie Yacht Club** in Staatsburg 845-889-4742 a few miles north of the bridge on the East shore.
- ☞ **Hudson River Maritime Museum** in Kingston 845-338-0071. They will be full with the antique boats 8/17 and 8/18, but it is a great stop with full town access.
- ☞ **Rondout Yacht Basin** in Kingston 845-331-7061 – (Sailboats may not be able to get under the bridge depending on mast height.) Nice pool and picnic area.
- ☞ **Kingston City Docks** 845-331-6940 are just past the bridge in town.
